

Andrea Blanch, Ph.D. selected for Yale Fellowship on Women, Religion and Globalization

CRT President and director, Andrea Blanch, has recently been named a Yale Fellow for 2009 in their program on *Women, Religion and Globalization*. The program is a collaboration between the MacMillan Center, the Yale Divinity School, and Women, Gender and Sexuality Studies, funded by the Luce Foundation. It explores the relationship between women religious practitioners and political, economic, and social developments, both locally, around the world, and in the larger context of international affairs.

One of three fellows selected from an international pool of candidates, Dr. Blanch will focus on the role of women of faith in building conditions of sustainable peace, bringing together her expertise in the area of trauma and violence and interfaith peacemaking with a particular focus on the Middle East.
