Project Summary: 1325 Woman and Peace

The project, 1325 Women and Peace, also known as 1325 Women Making Peace, and Women 4 Peace, is an ongoing online social enterprise, dedicated to inform on issues concerning women and peace. The project contains two online initiatives: a website and a facebook page, and one field meeting - a workshop on the creation of an online campaign for peace.

The Website

The mini-grant enabled the building of a <u>website</u> dedicated to the subject of 1325 Women and Peace. The site contains the UN Resolution 1325 in three languages: **Hebrew, English and Arabic**. It links to women and peace organizations around the world, and contains articles and photos of women who dedicate their time to bringing forth peace.




A Facebook Page

The website that was built is connected to a facebook page (http://www.facebook.com/WomenIsrael). The page has so far gathered 347 likes from people in Israel and around the world.



The facebook page is updated a couple of times each month, with current events concerning women around the world.

The Workshop

A workshop was held on 28/12/12 at John Brice College in Tel Aviv. Eighteen women: Jewish, Christian and Muslim women were attended.





The aim of the workshop was to introduce the site, and to demonstrate a mini campaign dedicated to women voicing their opinions on the topic of women and peace.

The photos of the campaign and a short clip were uploaded to the site and the facebook page and gathered a lot of interest.

Irit Hakim who participated in the workshop has written an <u>article</u> about it, in the site *Safe World for Women*. The article received over hundred likes and was shared multiple times.

Impact

The site and the facebook page continue to gather interest and are an ongoing source of information on the issue of 1325 women and peace. Furthermore, the workshop was extremely successful and participants would like to attend similar meeting in the future.
